While teaching at New York University, Laurie's plays were heralded all over the country and Ireland. Today, she writes from her home in Arizona, concentrating on both plays and novels that give young adults a voice. In July, her play *All of Us* was selected as "Best of the Best" at the Kansas City Fringe Festival. Her writers' workshop and its practical, hands-on approach will help young people and adults find *their* voice and the means to express it.



A Master's Degree graduate in Educational Theatre from New York University, Diane Lutz is an award winning educator and director. Lutz been a member of the Beaver Dam Wisconsin faculty Since 1980. Lutz has been an adjunct faculty member for the University of Wisconsin-Madison Summer Drama Institute and Marian College in Fond du lac Wisconsin, teaching graduate courses helping teachers develop drama activities across the curriculum. In 2007, Lutz received the American Alliance for Theatre and Education Teacher of the Year award.
